Purpose of Consultancy:	UNFPA's Strategic Plan 2018-2021 puts a significant emphasis on innovation. It sends a clear signal: UNFPA is changing to achieve transformative results. Strengthened partnerships, the systematic pursuit of innovation and knowledge, and more effective collaboration within the United Nations system are all critical elements. A revamped global corporate innovation strategy puts bold action to identify solutions, build alliances and amplify impact at the centre of UNFPA programmes.		
	Building on the global innovation strategy, UNFPA in Latin America and the Caribbean is committed to encouraging constructive risk-taking, collaboration, stronger associative thinking, and a greater emphasis on sharing and disseminating knowledge.
